Why Mee Plant (Madhuca longifolia)?

"Instead of just donating a meal for one day; why not nurture the agriculture to provide meals forever..."

- In this current economic crisis we are expecting a food shortage due to the lack of fertilizers. Mee plant is known to be the best natural fertilizer which will help with paddy fields.
- Release oxygen during the day and at night.(Normal tree would release O2 in the day and CO2 in the night)
- Seeds are natural pest repellent and it releases fertilizers rich in Urea and Nitrogen that are used in Agriculture.
- Planted in water will result in nutrition-rich liquid fertiliser to be carried away to downstream paddy fields.

This year, We are planning to plant all 100,000 Mee plants across the country

How to save 40,800 lives?


- We started to build a Non-communicable disease screeing centre for the under privilage people
- This Hospital will serve 40,800 lives annually.



Why a Screening Center?

- After a proper evaluation, World Health Organization has declared that 75% of deaths in Sri Lanka are due to non-communicable diseases and has advised to build screening centers across country
- · Therefore, we decided to build one!
- This will be the First Lion Non-communicable disease Screening Center in Sri Lanka
